The lightweight yet robust Evolution case makes the kit portable, allowing the first aider to take it directly to the site of the incident. The bleed control kit is ideal for high-risk industries, such as construction, industrial and agricultural, where there is a risk of severe injury. Having a tourniquet and haemostatic gauze included in a workplace first aid kit ensures that any injury with lifethreatening bleeding can be treated. Having our Evolution Plus Critical Injury Bleed Control Kit in the workplace is essential for those that are in more isolated locations, where it may take longer for emergency services to reach the casualty. Normally an ambulance arrives within 9 minutes in the UK, but this will depend on availability and the location they are travelling to, which can impact the injured parties' chance of survival. With the supplies provided in this kit, staff are able to treat any injuries that may have occurred and prolong the casualty's life until paramedics arrive.  HypaCover Trauma Dressings (Large) – These dressings absorb larger volumes of exudate than normal dressings, allowing pressure to be maintained with the dressings needing to be removed less frequently.

- **HypaTouch Nitrile Gloves** Having gloves reduces the risk of infection both to the wound and to the first aider from blood borne viruses.
- HypaStop Haemostatic Dressings (10cm x 10cm) These dressings are specially treated wound dressings designed to rapidly stop bleeding, especially in severe or life-threatening situations. They contain agents that accelerate the blood clotting process when applied directly to a wound.
- HypaGuard Foil Blanket Ideal for casualties in shock or suffering from hypothermia.
   Emergency Tourniquet - Apply the tourniquet
- Emergency Tourniquet Apply the tourniquet above the wound and tighten to stop blood flow, thus stopping the life-threatening bleeding.

  Clothing Cutters Removes clothing that is obstructing access to the wound or preventing first aid treatment from taking place.
