Did you know?

The handy 'Tax' function allows you to program and store any set percentage that can then be easily added or subtracted at the touch of a button, which is particularly useful for calculations where you need to add or subtract VAT.

To program a rate simply enter your rate and then press \fbox{RATE} followed by \fbox{STORE} .

Once the rate is set simply pressing the **+TAX** key adds the set percentage, or pressing **-TAX** deducts the set percentage.

Pressing the **+TAX** or **-TAX** keys again will also tell you the actual value of the percentage you have added or subtracted.
