
HOW TO USE A HIDDEN CAM & CAM SCREW OR CAM DOWEL


1. <u>NOTE</u>: Various CAM SCREWS or a CAM DOWEL may be used.







Turn the CAM SCREW or gently tap the CAM DOWEL until the shoulder is against the surface of the part.











- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- Turn twelve CAM SCREWS (2) into the ENDS (A and B), TOP (C), BOTTOM (D), and MOLDING (G).




Remember: Righty tighty. Lefty loosey.




Push twelve HIDDEN CAMS (1) into the ENDS (A and B) and SHELF (F).




- Insert two WOOD DOWELS (3) into the MOLDING (G).
- Fasten the MOLDING (G) to the SHELF (F). Tighten two HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the MOLDING insert into the SHELF.



- Insert two WOOD DOWELS (3) into the RIGHT END (B).
- Fasten the SHELF (F) to the RIGHT END (B). Tighten the HIDDEN CAM.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the RIGHT END insert into the SHELF.




- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (3) into the RIGHT END (B).
- Push the SMALL BACK (E) onto the WOOD DOWELS in the RIGHT END (B).




- Insert six WOOD DOWELS (3) into the SMALL BACK (E) and SHELF (F).
- Fasten the LEFT END (A) to the SMALL BACK (E) and SHELF (F). Tighten the HIDDEN CAM in the SHELF.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SMALL BACK and SHELF insert into the LEFT END.






- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (3) into the BOTTOM (D).
- Fasten the ENDS (A and B) to the BOTTOM (D). Tighten four HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the BOTTOM insert into the ENDS.




- Insert six WOOD DOWELS (3) into the ENDS (A and B) and BACK (E).
- Fasten the TOP (C) to the ENDS (A and B) and BACK (E). Tighten four HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the ENDS and BACK insert into the TOP.




- Turn your unit onto its front edges.
- Place the LARGE BACK (H) into the groove of the
- ENDS (A and B) and fasten it to your unit using the NAILS (7).




- You must fasten your unit to one wall stud and one WALL ANCHOR (6).
- You will need to locate a stud in your wall to fasten your unit. Determine the desired height of unit on your wall and move 1-5/8" downward on the center line of the wall stud. Mark this location on your wall as shown below.
- 2. The second mark will be for the WALL ANCHOR (6). This hole should be 15-1/8" horizontally from the first mark in part 1. To do this, place a level onto a horizontal straight edge from your wall stud mark to the second hole location for the WALL ANCHOR. Mark this location onto the wall as shown below.
- NOTE: Be sure the two marks are level before going to the next step.



- On the marks, drill a 3/32" hole in the center of a wall stud and a 7/16" hole in your wall for the WALL ANCHOR (6).
- Next, push the wings of the WALL ANCHOR (6) together, while inserting the WALL ANCHOR into the 7/16" hole until it is even with the surface of the wall.



- With the help of another person, fasten your unit to the wall. Use two 2-7/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (8) into the wall stud and into the WALL ANCHOR.
- Peel BLACK APPLIQUES from the BLACK APPLIQUE CARD (4) and stick them onto each visible HIDDEN CAM.
- Peel WHITE APPLIQUES from the WHITE APPLIQUE CARD (5) and stick them onto the screw heads in the BACK (E).
- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.
