


While not all parts are labeled, some of the parts will have a label or an inked letter on the edge to help distinguish similar parts from each other. Use this part identification to help identify similar parts.

- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- Separate the EXTENSION SLIDES (2) from the EXTENSION RAILS (1) as shown in the upper diagram below. Be prepared, the parts are greasy.
- Fasten the EXTENSION RAILS (1) to the ENDS/UPRIGHTS (C and D). Use six 3/8" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (16).
- NOTE: For each EXTENSION RAIL, turn a SCREW into the hole shown in the enlarged diagram. Then, slide the inner cartridge of the EXTENSION RAIL in to find the other holes that lines up with the holes in the END./UPRIGHTS. Turn a SCREW into these holes.
- NOTE: The EXTENSION SLIDES (2) will be used later for the DRAWERS.
- Repeat this step.










HOW TO USE A HIDDEN CAM & CAM SCREW OR CAM DOWEL













- Fasten the SHORT BRACES (P) to the UPRIGHT FRAMES (R). Tighten four 1-3/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS (13) using the L-WRENCH (9).
- Fasten the END FRAMES (Q) to the SHORT BRACES (P). Tighten four 1-3/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS (13) using the L-WRENCH (9).
- NOTE: Do not completely tighten the 1-3/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS at this time.





- Fasten the BOTTOMS (O) to the UPRIGHT FRAMES (R) and END FRAMES (Q). Turn four 1-3/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS (13) using the L-WRENCH (9).
- NOTE: Do not completely tighten the 1-3/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS at this time.
- Turn eight ADJUSTABLE GLIDES (6) completely into the UPRIGHT FRAMES (R) and the END FRAMES (Q).
- NOTE: The ADJUSTABLE GLIDES are used to level your desk and will be adjusted after the unit is standing upright in the last step.






- Stand your unit upright.
- Fasten the CABINET BOTTOMS (F) to the SHORT BRACES (P). Tunn eight 1-3/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS (13) using the L-WRENCH (9).
- NOTE: Do not completely tighten the 1-3/8" HEX HEAD SCREWS at this time.





- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (5) into a set of DRAWER SIDES (H and J).
- Fasten the DRAWER SIDES (H and J) to a DRAWER BACK (K) and a DRAWER BOX FRONT (L). Use eight 1-3/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (15).
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the DRAWER SIDES insert into the DRAWER BOX FRONT and DRAWER BACK.
- Slide the DRAWER BOTTOM (N) into the groove of the DRAWER SIDES (H and J) and DRAWER BACK (K).
- Repeat this step.




- Flip the drawer over.
- Push a FILE GLIDE (8) onto the top edges of a BACK (K) and DRAWER BOX FRONT (L).
- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (5) into the edges of the DRAWER SIDES (H and J).


If you're doing this to help a friend, don't leave without a bite.

Fasten a DRAWER FRONT (G) to the DRAWER BOX FRONT (L). Use four 7/8" PAN HEAD SCREWS (17).


Repeat this step.








- Fasten two EXTENSION SLIDES (2) to a set of DRAWER SIDES (H and J). Use six 3/8" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (16).
- Fasten a PULL (7) to a DRAWER FRONT (G). Use two 1-1/4" MACHINE SCREWS (14).
- Repeat this step.



- To insert a drawer into your unit, line up the EXTENSION SLIDES on the drawer with the EXTENSION RAILS on the unit and push the drawer into the unit until the drawer is fully inserted. The drawer will push in hard until it is all the way in, then it will slide in and out easier.
- ▼ Peel the APPLIQUE from the APPLIQUE CARD (10) and stick it onto the HIDDEN CAM in the MODESTY PANEL.
- Place your desk in its final location. Turn all ADJUSTABLE GLIDES downward until they touch the floor.
- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.

 Overloaded shelves or drawers. Improper loading can cause the product to be top-heavy. 	 Risk of injury. Top-heavy furniture can tip over. Overloaded shelves and drawers can break. 	 Never exceed the weight limits shown in the instructions. Work from bottom to top when loading shelves and drawers. Place the heavier items on the lower shelves or in lower drawers.
• Improperly moving furniture that is not designed and equipped with casters.	 Furniture can tip over or break if improperly moved. Physical injury. Furniture can be very heavy. Breakage of tops - particularly with double pedestal furniture (drawers at both ends). 	 Unload shelves and drawers from top to bottom before moving the unit. Do not push furniture, especially on a carpeted floor. Have a friend help you lift the item and set it in place. Provide support to the center section of the top when lifting the furniture.
