






#### Part Identification






- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- Push thirty-two HIDDEN CAMS (1) into the TOP (C), BOTTOM (D), SHELVES (E, F, and G), SKIRTS (I), and FEET (J and K).




Turn thirty-two CAM SCREWS (2) into the exact holes shown in the ENDS (A and B), BOTTOM (D), and FEET (J and K). (32 used)


Insert thirty-two LARGE WOOD DOWELS (3) into the exact holes shown in the edges of the ENDS (A and B), TOP (C), BOTTOM (D), SHELVES (E, F, and G), SKIRTS (I), and FEET (J and K).






- Fasten the SKIRTS (I) to the FEET (J and K). Tighten four HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SKIRTS insert into the FEET.






Fasten the SKIRTS (I) and FEET (J and K) to the BOTTOM (D). Tighten eight HIDDEN CAMS.

NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SKIRTS and FEET insert into the BOTTOM.





Fasten the TOP MOLDING (L) to the TOP (C). Use four BLACK 1-1/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (12).

NOTE: Do not over tighten the SCREWS into the TOP.




- Insert two SMALL WOOD DOWELS (4) into the FEET (J and K).
- Fasten the LEFT END (B) to the TOP (C), BOTTOM (D), and SHELVES (E, F, and G). Tighten ten HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the TOP, BOTTOM, SHELVES, and FEET insert into the LEFT END.





- Insert two SMALL WOOD DOWELS (4) into the FEET (J and K).
- Fasten the RIGHT END (A) to the TOP (C), BOTTOM (D), and SHELVES (E, F, and G). Tighten ten HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the TOP, BOTTOM, SHELVES, and FEET insert into the RIGHT END.




- Carefully turn your unit over onto its front edges. Unfold the BACK (O) and lay it over your unit.
- Make equal margins along all four edges of the BACK (O). Push on opposite corners of your unit if needed to make it "square".
- Fasten the BACK (O) to your unit using the NAILS (11).
- NOTE: Be sure to tap NAILS into the holes that line up over the SHELVES (E, F, and G).
- NOTE: Perforations have been provided for access through the BACK. Carefully cut out the holes needed.




Do <u>not</u> stand the unit upright without the BACK fastened. The unit may collapse.






- Carefully stand your unit upright. Place your unit in its final location against a wall.
- We recommend using the FURNITURE TIPPING RESTRAINT KIT (99) for added stability. Fasten a bracket to the TOP (C) using the 5/8" screw as shown.
- Follow the instructions included in the KIT to fasten your unit to the wall.






- Push the RUBBER SLEEVES (9) over the METAL PINS (8). Insert the METAL PINS into the hole locations of your choice in the ENDS (A and B). Set the ADJUSTABLE SHELF (H) onto the METAL PINS.
- Peel a sticker from the APPLIQUE CARD (10) and place onto each visible HIDDEN CAM.




- Fasten the GUIDES (5 and 6) to the DOORS (M and N) exactly as shown. Use sixteen BLACK 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).
- Fasten the DOOR HANDLES (7) to the DOORS (M and N). Use eight BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (13).




NOTE: The UPPER GUIDE (5) tabs should be down before starting this step.

- Insert the LOWER GUIDES (6) in the LEFT DOOR (M) at an angle into the rear track in the BOTTOM (D). Then, tilt the LEFT DOOR (M) up vertically. Push the UPPER GUIDE (5) tabs up into the rear track in the LOWER SHELF (G).
- NOTE: The DOOR should slide freely in the track.
- Repeat this step for the RIGHT DOOR (N) using the front tracks in the BOTTOM (D) and LOWER SHELF (G).



- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with your favorite furniture polish or a damp cloth. Wipe dry.
